OVER ONE LAKH CANDIDATES GSHSEB To DECLARE GUJCET RESULTS TODAY

Gujarat Secondary and Higher Secondary Education Board (GSHSEB) will declare Gujarat Grammar Entrance Test (GUJCET) results on September 5 at 8 am on its official website, the GSHSEB stated. Over 1.06 lakh candidates took the GUJCET on August 24 at 621 buildings at 34 centres across Gujarat.

HEARING OF COVID PILs IN GUJARAT HC

Stay on coercive action against Rajasthan Hospital

THE GUJARAT High Court (HC) on Friday ordered a stay on coercive actions against Rajasthan Hospital in Ahmedabad on Friday, after the latter challenged the order by the Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation, which had imposed a fine of Rs 77 lakh.

The penalty was imposed on the hospital by the urban local body in June-end after a delay in admitting a Covid-19 patient resulted in his death leading the court to make strong observations against the mismanagement. The patient was initially admitted to Lifecare Hospital but was arranged to be transferred to Rajasthan Hospital after it was adjudged that the patient required ventilator support. However, Rajasthan Hospital had allegedly kept the patient waiting for over 30 minutes, leading to his death. An FIR was also registered on behalf of the AMC against the board of management members and trustees of the hospital.

As per a source, the public prosecutor submitted before the court that CCTV footage from the hospital showed that the patient was kept waiting for 15 minutes instead of 30 minutes as is being claimed by the deceased's family members. However, the court sought an explanation as to why the patient was made to wait for even 15 minutes, given that hospital authorities were notified in advance of the transfer of the patient.

The division bench which was hearing the matter also issued notice to AMC, Lifeline Hospital and the state government, returnable in six weeks. The matter was taken up with a bunch of litigation related to issues surrounding Covid-19 in Gujarat.

In an affidavit filed by Bhavin Solanki, medical officer of health

Surat petitioners

The division bench of Gujarat HC disposed of a PIL moved by an NGO, Surat Citizens Council Trust, which had pointed out several practical difficulties faced in Surat, including insufficient body vans, delayed administering of life-saving drugs such as dexa-

methasone and Tocilizumab, instances where cashless mediclaim policies are not honoured by hospitals, etc. The disposal came after the petitioners submitted that they are satisfied with the present condition in Surat. It was also submitted that overall situation appears to have improved, especially with the basic issues of drug availability and health infrastructure.

Testing

Petitions moved by medical associations that had sought increased testing across the state as well as widely available testing facilities was disposed off. Advocate Rohan Shah who was representing the petitioners, told this paper that owing to the state government's compliance with the broad prayers of increased

testing and antigen tests making testing available to the masses, the petitions were disposed off.

Muharram clarification

The division bench quashed and set aside a notification issued by Kutch district collector's office, which barred observing Muharram at imambaras in the district.

A Kutch-based committee - Akhil Kutchb Moharam and Tajjiya Committee - represented by advocate Aman A Shaikh, had moved the HC earlier, specifically challenging a particular clause in the collector's notification that barred Muharram rituals at imambaras as well. The court clarified that gatherings of not more than 20 persons are permissible, as per standard operating protocol of safety.

Vadodara teacher gets CBSE award

Vadodara: A teacher from Navachitra International School in Vadodara has bagged the prestigious CBSE Teachers Award, declared every year by the Ministry of Education to mark Teachers' Day on September 5.

Iyer, a mathematics teacher, will receive a certificate and a cash prize of Rs. 50,000. The CBSE instituted this Award under the aegis of Ministry of Education to publicly recognise the contribution of meritorious teachers and principals of schools affiliated with CBSE. **ENS**

4 special trains for candidates attending NDA, NA entrance

THE WESTERN Railway will run four special trains for candidates attending entrance examinations of the National Defence Academy (NDA) and Naval Academy (NA) on Mumbai-Ahmedabad, Somnath-Ahmedabad, Pune-Ahmedabad and Patan-Ahmedabad routes on September 5. This is in the wake of regular trains being cancelled due to Covid-19 pandemic.

According to officials of the Western Railways, the candidates of NDA and NA will be allowed to board the trains after showing their call letters. All coaches of these trains will be fully reserved.

The special trains are train number 09081/0902 Mumbai Central-Ahmedabad-Mumbai Central Superfast special, which will depart from Mumbai Central at 9.35 pm on Saturday and reach Ahmedabad next day at 5.30 am. On return, this train will depart from Kalupur railway station in Ahmedabad at 10:10 pm on September 6 and reach Mumbai next day at 6.05 am. The train will halt at Vadodara, Bharuch, Surat,

Palghar and Borivli. Train number 09201/09202 Somnath-Ahmedabad-Somnath Superfast Special will leave Somnath at 9.25 pm on September 5 and reach Ahmedabad next day at 5 am. On return, the train will leave Ahmedabad on September 6 around 10.10 pm and reach Somnath next day at 5.35 am. This train will also have Third AC, Sleeper and General coaches and will halt at Junagadh, Bhaktinagar, Rajkot, Surendranagar and Viramgam. Train number number 09401/09402 Patan-Ahmedabad-Patan Demu passenger Special will leave Patan on September 6 at 5.30 am and reach Ahmedabad 08. 05 am. The train will leave Ahmedabad at 6 pm and reach Patan at 8.20 pm on September 6. The train will halt at Mehsana, Kalol, Gandhinagar and Sabarmati.
